


106 Advanced Seminar: Charlotte, NC

The Section 106 Advanced Seminar will be held on Tuesday, April 2, 2013

Important note: Classes are filled on a first come/first served basis of registrations received with payment at the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (ACHP). You must be confirmed by the ACHP to be admitted to class.

Registration: Payment may be made by on-line credit card registration or by check or SF 182. Go to: <http://www.achp.gov/106advanced.html> to register.

Course Location and Accommodations: The course is being held at The Dunhill Hotel, 237 N. Tryon Street, Charlotte, NC 28202 (<http://www.dunhillhotel.com/>). A limited block of rooms has been secured for attendees for Tuesday, April 1 at the government rate of \$97 for a single occupancy plus applicable state and local tax (15.25%). **It is recommended that you make your reservations early, as the rooms are likely to sell out. Reservations must be made by March 1, 2013.** Reservations made after that date will be accepted on a space available basis at whatever rate is available at the time of the reservation. **To reserve your room**, call central reservations at 704-332-4141 and request the ACHP – Section 106 Advanced group block.



Traveling to Charlotte: Charlotte is served by the Charlotte Douglas International Airport (<http://charlottedouglasintlairport.com/>). The airport is approximately 7 miles from The Dunhill.

Parking at Hotel: Self parking is available at \$12 per night and valet parking at \$18 per night.

Hotel Information: The Charlotte Dunhill Hotel is one of North Carolina's Historic Hotels of America and one of its first luxury establishments. Designed by architect Louis Asbury, Sr., the hotel originally opened in 1929 as the Mayfair Manor. The ten-story hotel has been fully restored and is a landmark in the arts community and

cultural district. The Hotel is one of Charlotte's few remaining historic landmarks from a distinctive period in history.

Registration: Registration will be located outside the conference room on Tuesday at 8:00 a.m. Plan to stop by the registration desk to check in and to pick up your course notebook and other course materials.

Schedule: *The Advanced Seminar* runs from 8:30 a.m. to approximately 4:30 p.m. Short breaks will be given in the morning and afternoon with a longer break for lunch.

Meals: Light morning fare and an afternoon snack are provided. The cost of this food is included in your registration fee. All other meals are on your own.
